## HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS

A member from the Shelby County Libraries Home-Bound Services will select materials for your reading and viewing pleasure.

You choose between regular and large print, fiction and non-fiction books. You may also choose from a large selection of magazines.

Audiovisual materials such as videos, CD's, DVD's and audiobooks are available.

Items can be delivered and picked up from your home at a time convenient for you.

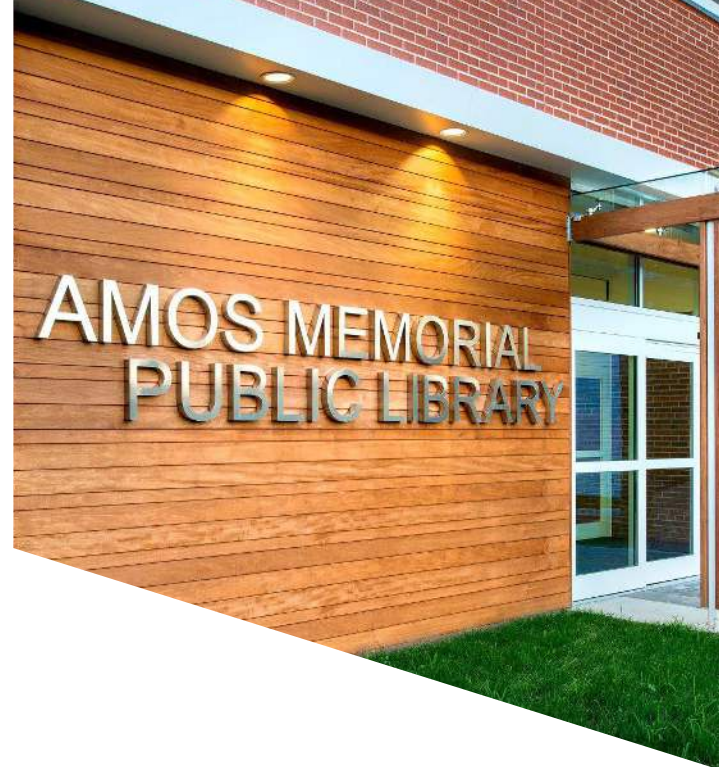
If you are a Shelby County resident who is unable to visit the library due to mobility, health or disability barriers, let us bring the library to you.
